



Krys Huba (they/ them) works with painting, installation, writing, and performance. Their works reflect what it means to live in the present and how desires, memories, and repression shape this experience.

Huba's works are presented nationally and internationally, most recently in solo exhibitions at Künstlerhaus Bethanien (Berlin, 2025), Mouches Volantes (Cologne, 2024) and Kunstraum Display (Berlin, 2022). Group exhibitions include presentations at the Biennale für Freiburg 2 (2023), Kunstverein Freiburg, Kunstraum Tropez / projectspacefestival (Berlin, 2023), during Zurich Art Weekend 2023, at Villa Renata (Basel, 2022), Museum im Bellpark (Kriens, 2020) and Tate Exchange/Tate Modern (London, 2019). In July 2025, Huba's works will be presented at Künstlerhaus Bethanien in their first institutional solo exhibition in Berlin.

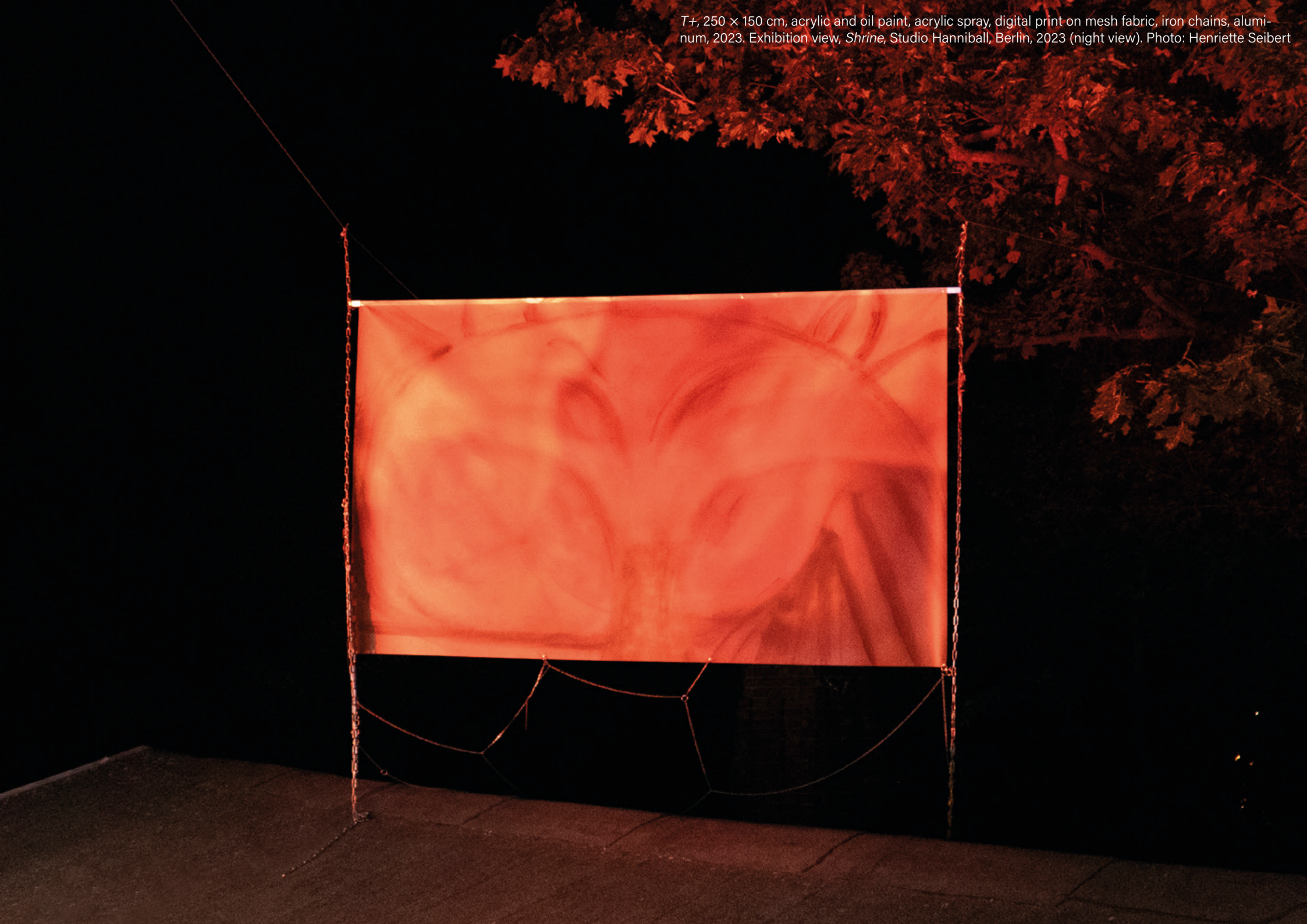
